

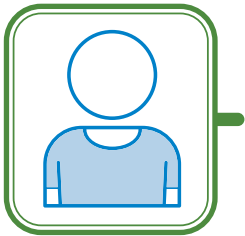

Measure Requirements

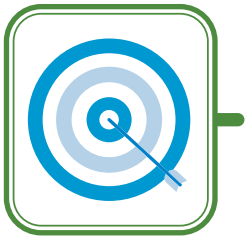
Members with diabetes (type 1 or type 2) who had a retinal eye exam in the measurement year (2023) or a dilated retinal eye exam that is negative for retinopathy in the year prior to the measurement year (2022) by an ophthalmologist or optometrist.

Note: CPT® code 3072F, which reflects history of a dilated retinal exam negative for retinopathy the year prior (2022), should be submitted on claims for patients who have a diagnosis of diabetes in the measurement year (2023) but had a dilated retinal exam that was negative for retinopathy in the year prior to the measurement year (2022). Be sure to document in the patient’s medical chart, using code 3072F, to indicate that he or she had a negative result in the year prior to the measurement year (2022).



Member Requirements

Members who were with a practice for 11 consecutive months within the measurement year (2023) and who were 18 through 75 as of December 31 of the measurement year (2023) who were identified as diabetics through pharmacy data and claims/encounter data in the measurement year (2023) or the year prior to the measurement year (2022).

Options to close Care Gaps

- **Option 1:** Claim/encounter submission with appropriate coding.

Diabetic Retinopathy Screening Codes	
2022F	Dilated retinal eye exam with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed; with evidence of retinopathy
2023F	Dilated retinal eye exam with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed; without evidence of retinopathy
2024F	7 standard field stereoscopic photos with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed (DM)
2025F	7 standard field stereoscopic retinal photos with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed; without evidence of retinopathy
2026F	Eye imaging validated to match diagnosis from 7 standard field stereoscopic retinal photos results documented and reviewed (DM)
2033F	Eye imaging validated to match diagnosis from 7 standard field stereoscopic retinal photos results documented and reviewed; without evidence of retinopathy
3072F	Low risk for retinopathy (no evidence of retinopathy in the prior year)
