Help our Medicare Advantage members save on prescriptions at preferred pharmacies

Members with AmeriHealth Medicare Advantage plans can save money by filling their prescriptions at preferred pharmacies.

Effective January 1, 2025, most Medicare Advantage members with AmeriHealth coverage will pay \$0 for Tier 1 and Tier 2 prescriptions (which include most generic drugs) at our preferred pharmacies. At standard (non-preferred) pharmacies, our members will have copay amounts that vary by plan.

Home delivery/mail order

Most AmeriHealth Medicare Advantage members can save money by having eligible prescriptions shipped to their home for free through OptumRx[®] Home Delivery, administered by our pharmacy benefits manager.

Through mail order, most AmeriHealth Medicare Advantage members can get their prescriptions shipped to their home at the same cost-sharing as if they filled it at a preferred pharmacy. This includes 90-day supplies.

How can providers submit a new prescription for home delivery/mail order?



Write the member a prescription for a 90-day supply



Call Pharmacy Benefits

Call the Pharmacy Benefits number on the back of your patient's member ID card, select the physician option, and select the 90-day option.



Electronic prescription

Electronically submit the prescription for home delivery/mail order through <code>OptumRx®</code>.



Paper prescription

- AmeriHealth members must fill out a *Mαil-In Order Form*, which can be found at <u>amerihealthmedicare.com/mailorder</u>.
- If members have questions about signing up using a paper prescription, they can call the number on their ID card.
