

Help our Medicare Advantage members save on prescriptions at preferred pharmacies



Members with AmeriHealth Medicare Advantage plans can save money by filling their prescriptions at preferred pharmacies.

Effective January 1, 2026, most Medicare Advantage members with AmeriHealth coverage will pay \$0 for Tier 1 and Tier 2 prescriptions (which include most generic drugs) at our preferred pharmacies.* At standard (non-preferred) pharmacies, our members will have copay amounts that vary by plan.

If your electronic medical record (EMR) platform is integrated with Surescripts®, you can use that tool to review lower cost subclass alternatives for our members.

Home delivery/mail order

Most AmeriHealth Medicare Advantage members can save money by having eligible prescriptions shipped to their home for **free through OptumRx Home Delivery**.

OptumRx pharmacies offer the same cost-share as preferred pharmacies — AmeriHealth Medicare Advantage members pay **\$0 for Tier 1 and Tier 2 drugs.*** This includes **90-day supplies**.

Through mail order, most AmeriHealth Medicare Advantage members can get their prescriptions shipped to their home at the same cost-sharing as if they filled it at a preferred pharmacy.

Submit a new prescription for home delivery/mail order using these options:



Write the member a paper prescription for a 90-day supply

- AmeriHealth members must fill out a *Prescription Mail-In Order Form*, which can be found at [amerihealthmedicare.com/mailorder](https://www.amerihealthmedicare.com/mailorder).
- If members have questions about signing up using a paper prescription, they can call the number on their ID card.



Call Pharmacy Benefits

Call the Pharmacy Benefits number on the back of your patient's member ID card, select the physician option, and select the 90-day option.

Electronically submit the prescription for home delivery/mail order through OptumRx.
